



Iowa Premium recently partnered with a group of graduate students from Iowa State University. The students and faculty members brought several groups of cattle to the Tama facility in order to gather data as part of their graduate study research projects.

The first study focused on cattle performance and diet digestibility when sorghum silage was used as an alternative forage in feedlot diets. The object of the second study was to determine the influence of supplemental trace mineral source on trace mineral status, growth, and carcass performance in feedlot steers that were fed high sulfur diets.

The ISU group worked closely with Harvey Torres, Iowa Premium grading manager. As a company, we are excited to see students engaging in research for the betterment of the cattle industry. Iowa Premium looks forward to continued partnership with ISU.
